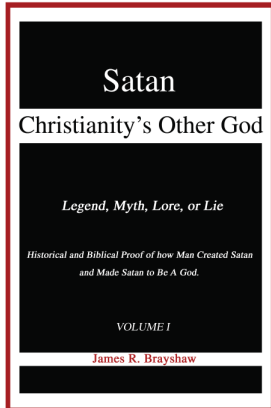


## CATHOLIC EXORCISTS PERPETUATE A MYTH .....Imagine There's No Satan.....

- The mythological serpent in the Garden of Eden is explained thoroughly and it's not a literal serpent or an appearance of Satan.
- If Satan has powers like God then Satan is like god. Can the God of the universe be mistaken in stating: *"there is none like me"*?
